



International Front Runners Statement Regarding Incident Involving Night Runners West Palm Beach on 24 November 2025

The International Front Runners Committee is aware of an incident reported in the United States involving members of one of our affiliated clubs, Night Runners West Palm Beach, in Florida on 24 November 2025.

Based on information publicly reported and shared with us, a driver allegedly used his car in an attempt to strike down members of Night Runners West Palm Beach. The incident is currently under investigation by the relevant authorities, including the state attorney and the FBI. We understand that this has been an extremely distressing experience for those directly affected.

International Front Runners is a global network of over 130 LGBT+ affirmative running clubs around the world representing over 11,000 athletes. Our clubs exist to provide safe, welcoming, and inclusive spaces for people to come together through sport and community. The safety, dignity, and wellbeing of our members and volunteers are of utmost importance to the Committee.

There is no place for hate crimes, violence, or intimidation against LGBT+ communities, runners, or any individual. The International Front Runners Committee takes all reports of such incidents involving our member clubs seriously and will continue to monitor this situation closely.

We stand in solidarity with Night Runners West Palm Beach and their members. Through our international network, we will do our best to provide support and share resources with the club and with any other member clubs that may require assistance in relation to safety, wellbeing, or incident response.

As this matter is subject to ongoing legal proceedings, it would not be appropriate to comment further at this time. We encourage anyone with relevant information to cooperate fully with law enforcement authorities.
